FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM MIDWINTER CONFERENCE - November 3rd, 4th and 5th, 2017

1. The contest is divided into two sections. The first section will be judged on contestant's appearance and a two-minute impromptu speech, Topics will be drawn from envelopes. One-half point will be deducted for each minute over or under the allotted time.
2. The second section will be for presentation of the contestant's talent which is not to exceed four minutes. There will be a 20-minute break for contestants to change costumes if necessary, between the first and second sections.
3. A special committee will be in charge of the judges, and will brief the contestants before the contest.
4. Any contestant who has already won a first place in this contest may not enter again.
5. Winners have 24 months in which to claim their scholarships.
6. Contestants must be between 16 and 22 years of age, married or single, male or female.
7. There will be three scholarships awarded. Typical awards are: first place - \$1,000.00 scholarship, second place - \$750.00 scholarship, third place - \$500.00 scholarship.
