# People Helping People From Around the Pacific NW

## Portland, Oregon

East Portland #3256 donated 300 pairs of diabetic socks to veterans at the VA Portland Health Care System.

## Lincoln City, Oregon

North Lincoln Eagles #2576 recently presented two checks totaling nearly \$1,200 to Gabriel Snow, a Junior at Taft High School. Gabriel has been nominated by the Congress of Future Science and Technology to represent the state of Oregon and Taft High School at their Congress in Boston, Mass., in July. Gabriel was selected for recognition because of his outstanding academic reputation and leadership potential. He will be studying with Nobel Prize winners and other world leaders in science.

## Ocean Shores, Washington

North Beach Eagles #4197 member Linda Hooper had spent four years climbing the Columbia Tower, the tallest building in Seattle, which is made up of 69 flights of stairs (1,311 stairs total), to raise money for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Nearing her mid-60s, she felt it was time to retire, passing the climbing duties on to her daughter and granddaughter. But suddenly, Hooper learned of the diagnosis of two-year-old Landry Hall, the nephew of a friend and fellow Eagle. Hooper decided to lace up her climbing shoes once again to support the cause. Upon learning of her return to the climb, the Aerie, spearheaded by Jr. Past Worthy President Paul Boatman, sponsored Linda for \$1,000. Soon, other members joined in the cause and by the time Hooper had scaled the tower, more than \$5,000 was raised for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society for a total of more than \$25,000 over the last five years. Hall's photo will be placed inside the tower as an inspiration to others.
