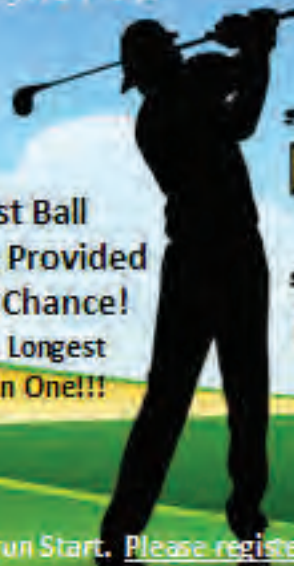

Eagles Diabetic Socks for Veterans Program

Tigard Eagle Riders with donations from the Eagle Riders from Woodburn, East Portland, Tigard, Medford Eagles, Eagle Auxiliary's, REAC, Region 1 & 2 and many of our friends have started a program to give 'Diabetic Socks for Veterans' and Information on foot care for free. Foot care is so

important for diabetics and diabetic socks are a simple start on the road to healthy foot care. If we can delay or prevent just one amputation it's worth it!!! Diabetic socks are expensive. This should not be the reason someone does not wear them. We can get them in bulk at a cost of just a little over a buck a pair. We plan to provide hundreds of pairs of socks a year for our Veterans and the Elderly. (We have given out over 10,000 pair in our first few years at the VA hospital and to our elderly at our Aerie) We are on our 5th year now with many more to come!

Boy Scout Troop #56 from East Portland Eagles and many of our friends help give them out at the Portland VA hospital. Our Friends in Yakima, Washington have now started a program to expand this to the VA hospitals in Washington.

As we say in our donation letter any donation that you can give will be put toward this project, 100%, there are no administration costs, and we are all volunteers! People Helping People!

Information on PAD (peripheral artery disease) is so very important as we age. Information on foot care is not just for diabetics, but of all of us, Veterans, our members, and others.

Our founder, Jeff Riffard, has been working hard at this and has not gotten only our Eagle Brothers and Sisters, but his friends, as well as the American Legion Post #1, Lions Club, Moose Lodge to pitch in and get donations as well as helping out to promote this throughout the United States.

We tell all our donors 'Thank you again for everything that you do to make our communities better for all of those in need'. You are truly People Helping People.

Portland VA has the highest amputation rate in the Nation. 'LET'S TURN THAT AROUND!' The VA has told us in a letter that in our first year 'WE HAVE MADE A DIFFERENCE!'

While giving Socks out at the VA last Summer Brother Jeff was asked if he could get some Veterans for a film shoot that week. We were offered a role in the movie with the Diabetic Sock for Veterans table in the movie. We set up the Table with a banner with the Eagles Logo and the Diabetic Socks. They contacted the Grand to see if they would put this in the movie, of course the answer was 'YES'. The movie should be out this year, 'Leave no Trace' with Ben Foster and Directed by Debra Granik, look for it soon.
