Statutes of the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Section 71.9 states ... Members not in good standing (failure to pay dues) shall not be permitted to hold or to remain in office, to attend the meetings, or social rooms of the Aerie, or to make use of any of its facilities...

So, if you were a member and you stop paying dues, you are no longer allowed to come into the Aerie or be served. You cannot be signed in as a guest. You will now have to pay a Re-enrollment fee, be voted on, plus your dues. **Dues were due June 1st.**
